- There are 179 higher education institutions in Turkey most of which (164) have ECHE (Erasmus Charter for Higher Education)

- Turkey's geographical position acts as a natural bridge between continents of Asia and Europe
- Turkey's climate conditions give various opportunities for sport and tourism

Erasmus+ Programme aims at equipping individuals with new skills, supporting their personal development, and increasing their employability. The Programme also helps organisations by generating opportunities for advancement in their sectors and enhancement of their capacities through establishment of cooperative relationships with other organisations.

What is Erasmus+?

Erasmus+ is the European Union Programme for education, training, youth and sport between 2014-2020. Erasmus+ Programme is implemented by Turkish National Agency in Turkey.

Why Erasmus+?

Erasmus+ Programme enables major contribution to help tackle socio-economic changes through education, training, youth and sport projects. Europe will be facing novel challenges in the upcoming decade. To support the implementation of the European policy agenda for growth, jobs, equity, social inclusion and meet the needs of the decade, Erasmus+ Programme will create new opportunities for the whole Europe. The specific objectives of Erasmus+ Programme are as follows:

- to improve the level of key competences and skills
- to strengthen the co-operation between education/training and business sectors
- to foster the quality of improvements, excellence of innovation and globalization
- to promote the social inclusion of disadvantaged people
- to improve the teaching and learning of language skills, and promote the EU's broad linguistic diversity and intercultural awareness

What kind of activities are supported?

Learning Mobility of Individuals (Key Action 1):

- Studying and training abroad
- Teaching and learning abroad
- Projects for youth and volunteering

Cooperation for Innovation, and the Exchanges of Good Practices (Key Action 2):

- Development, transfer and/or implementation of innovative practices
- Implementation of joint initiatives promoting cooperation

Support for Policy Reform (Key Action 3):

- Meetings between young people and decision-makers in the field of youth
- Events simulating the functions of the democratic institutions

Jean Monnet Activities :

- Educational activities (MA, PhD) aiming at promoting the excellence of teaching and research in the field of European Union studies worldwide
- Activities aiming at fostering the dialogue between the academic world and policy-makers

Sport:

- Activities aiming at tackling with doping, match fixing and violence, as well as all kinds of intolerance and discrimination
- Activities aiming at promoting and supporting fair and professional management in sport
- Activities aiming the athletes continue their education as they perform their professional sport careers

Who can apply?

Any organization active in the field of education, training, youth and sport

Who can participate?

- **Individuals:** students, trainees, apprentices, pupils, adult learners, young people, volunteers, professors, teachers, trainers, youth workers
- **Institutions and organizations active in the fields of education, training and youth and sport:** schools, universities, public and private organizations, NGOs, youth groups, sport organizations
